ABOUT THE CHOIR:

As a national children's choir, the choir member will receive professional musical and singing tuition from voice coaches, as well as exposure and experience through performing alongside famous South African artists; to be a demonstration choir at choral workshops; on occasion they will have the opportunity to perform for television broadcasts; and to travel and represent South Africa abroad.

Sing in Harmony National Children's Choir wants to teach these highly talented choristers' self-discipline by studying their music from home and in groups, to inspire self-confidence by singing in front of large crowds and provide the opportunity to make new friends from across the country.

Above all, Sing in Harmony National Children's Choir is aiming to become a world class performing choir which will be incredibly beneficial for your child's personal development.

- First-round video and online auditions: The deadline for all choir audition submissions is Wednesday, 15 November.
- Invitation to the final physical rehearsal: Choristers who successfully pass the first round of video auditions will receive notifications and be invited to a physical rehearsal by Wednesday, November 15.
- Second Round Physical Auditions with Karina Erasmus: These will take place on Sunday, November 19, in the Pretoria area.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- The Sing in Harmony National Children's Choirs is for all children, boys and girls, aged 8 – 14.
- A choir member is expected to sing until the end of his/her Grade 8 year. This is essential for their musical development, to maintain the very high standards of the choir and the maintenance of a knowledgeable and experienced core group.

- Physical choir rehearsals take place once a month during the school term on a Saturday or Sunday from about 09h00 – 16h00 at a venue in Pretoria. Change in venues, dates and times will always be communicated in advance.
- Online rehearsals and choral homework will be given to the choristers on a weekly basis. It will be expected of choristers to do self-study of the material they receive at home, with the assistance of a dedicated voice coach.
- By submitting your audition video, you agree to abide by the rules and guidelines set forth
- Participation in the choir is contingent upon successful audition results, and all decisions regarding choir membership are final.
- Choir members are expected to attend rehearsals regularly and participate actively in all choir activities and performances.
- Sing in Harmony reserves the right to make changes to the choir schedule, repertoire, and other details as needed, and members will be informed of any such changes in a timely manner.
- Choir members are expected to maintain a respectful and collaborative attitude toward fellow choristers and choir leadership.
- Sing in Harmony may record and use audio/video recordings or photographs of choir performances for promotional and educational purposes.
